

Why Symbols?

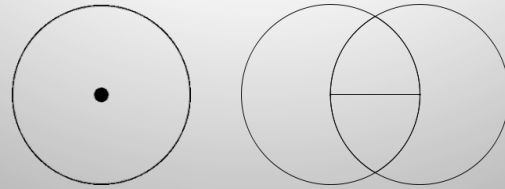

Why Symbols?

“By symbols men have ever sought to communicate to each other those thoughts which transcend the limitations of language. Rejecting man conceived dialects as inadequate and unworthy to perpetuate divine ideas, the Mysteries thus chose symbolism as a far more ingenious and ideal method of preserving their transcendental knowledge. In a single figure a symbol may both reveal and conceal, for to the wise the subject of the symbol is obvious, while to the ignorant the figure remains inscrutable. Hence, he who seeks to unveil the secret doctrine of antiquity must search for that doctrine not upon the open pages of books which might fall into the hands of the unworthy but in the place where it was originally concealed.” (Manly P. 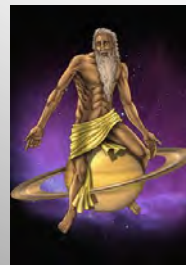
The Purpose of Symbols

- To conceal meaning from those who are ignorant or unworthy.
- To reveal ones identity or association to another who recognizes its significance

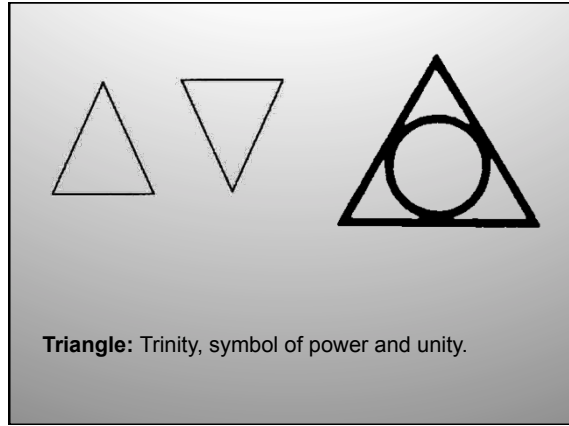


Circle: Sun Disc, Vesica Piscis (“bladder of a fish”)

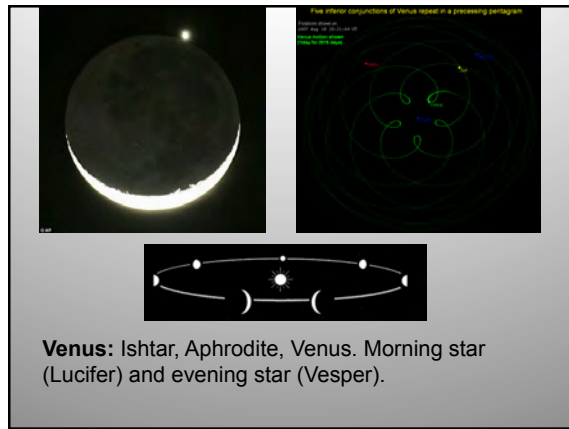
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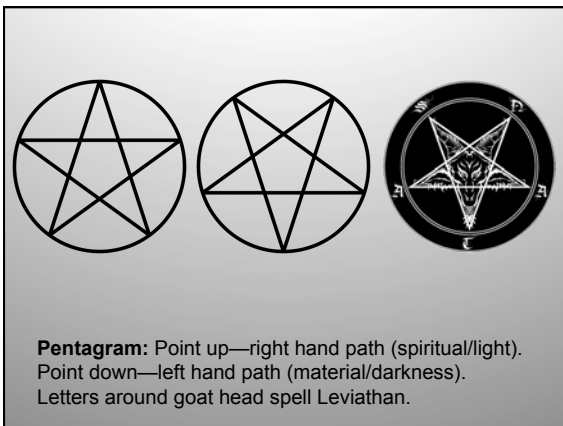
Saturn: Is associated with abundance as well as dominance. Saturn and Jupiter are two dualistic forces.



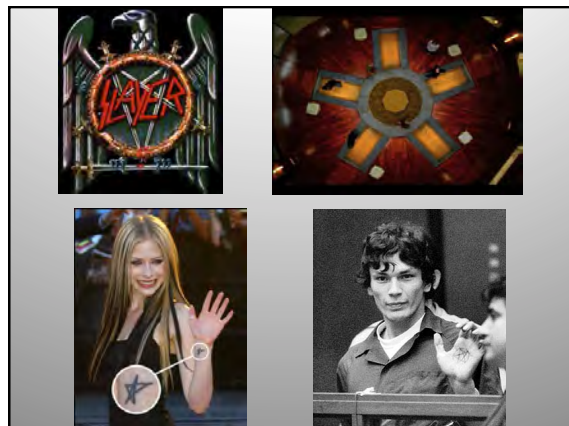
Triangle: Trinity, symbol of power and unity.

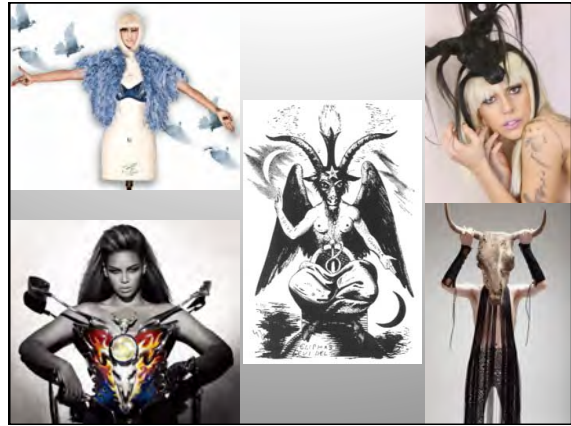
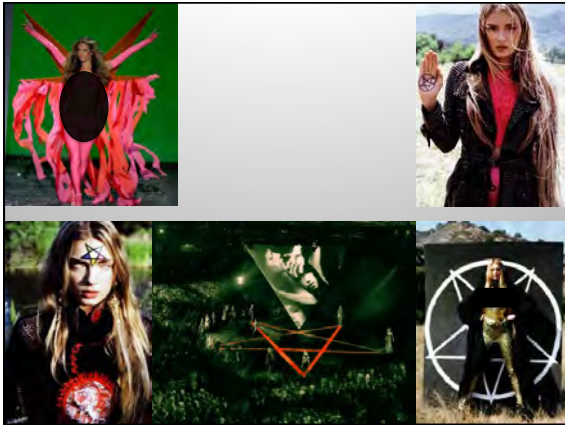



Venus: Ishtar, Aphrodite, Venus. Morning star (Lucifer) and evening star (Vesper).



Pentagram: Point up—right hand path (spiritual/light).
Point down—left hand path (material/darkness).
Letters around goat head spell Leviathan.

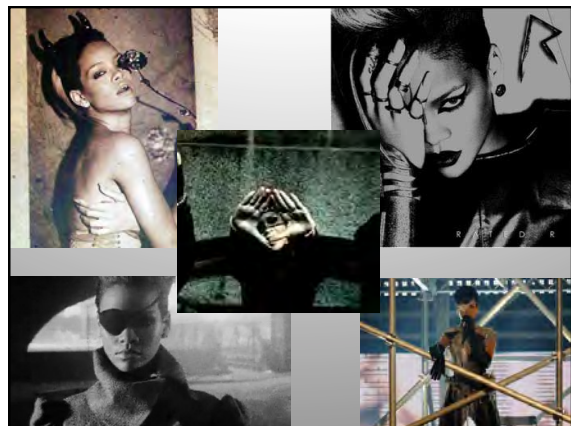


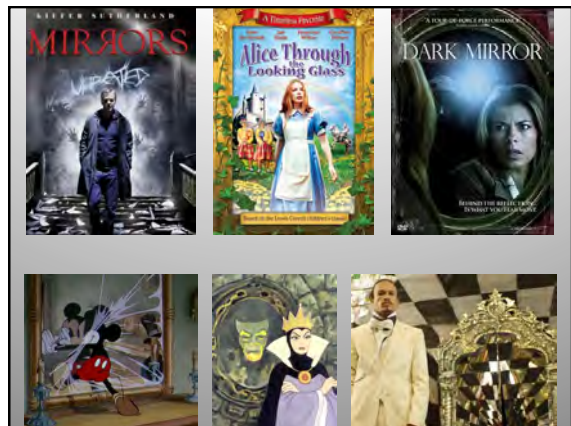
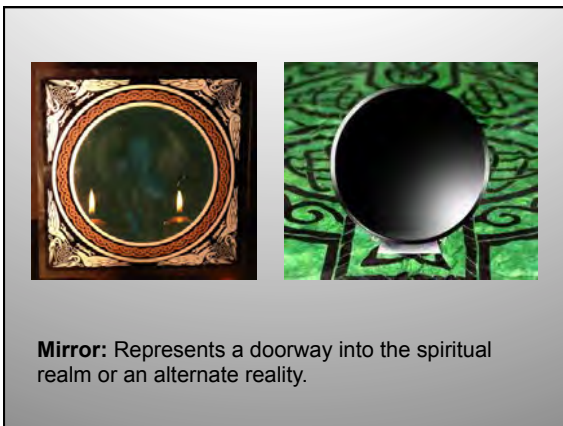
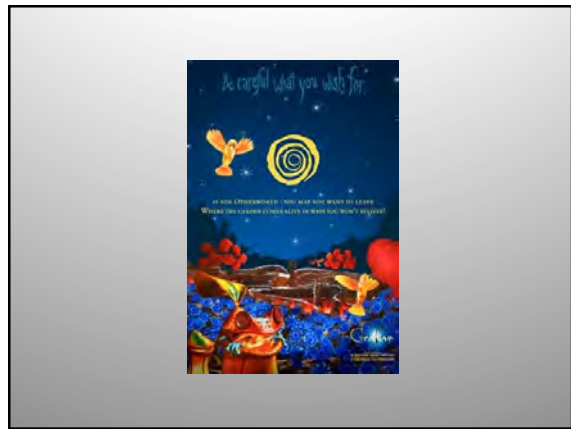
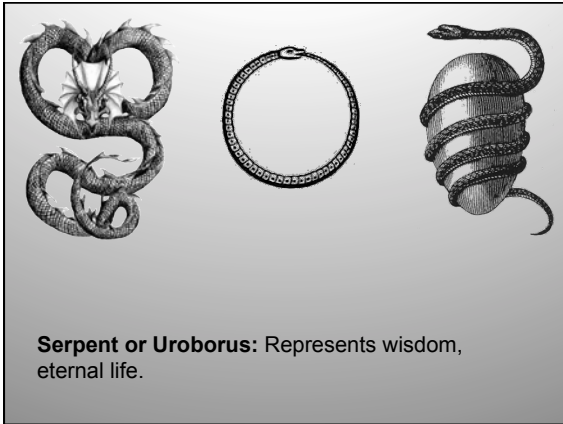



Hexagram: Represents the spiritual realm above and the material realm below.



All Seeing Eye: Image of Horus and Enlightenment.



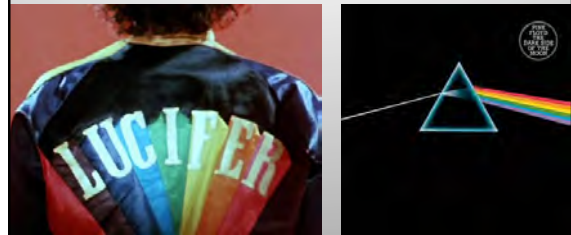




Hanged Man: Represents a sacrifice that brings enlightenment.



Rainbow: Represents a bridge from the material realm into the spiritual realm or an alternate reality.



Colors

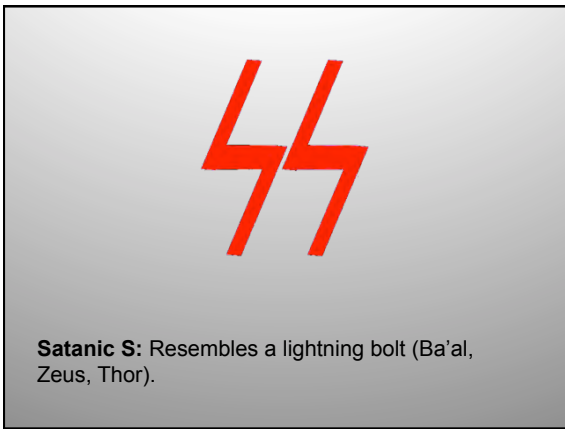
- **Purple:** Power, authority
- **Blue:** Spiritual realm, spirit of man, protection
- **Yellow:** earth, Mind, spirit, golden path
- **Orange:** Pivot between two worlds, fertility
- **Green:** Nature
- **Red:** Body, sacrifice, blood, hell, irrational
- **White:** Purity, innocence



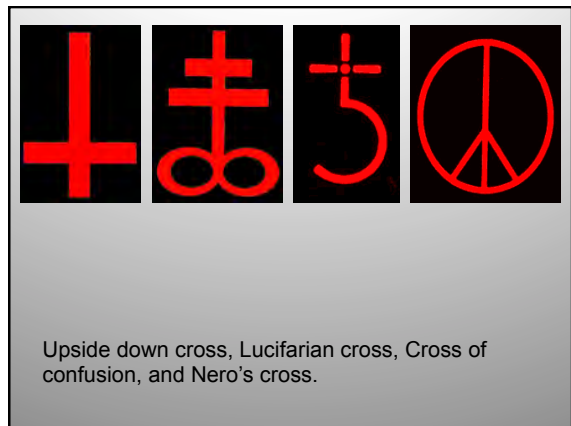
Winged Disc: Egyptian symbol of life and fertility.
Ankh: Top portion represents the female, the lower portion represents the male.



Swastika: Widely used in Eastern Dharmic religions such as Hinduism, Buddhism and Jainism.



Satanic S: Resembles a lightning bolt (Ba'al, Zeus, Thor).



Upside down cross, Lucifarian cross, Cross of confusion, and Nero's cross.
